Before the parade - Help us decorate! - Saturday, August 12, 5–7:30 p.m. - Spot in parade and cross street information are unconfirmed. Will be shared by end of week.

Walking in the parade: Saturday, August 12, 7:30 p.m. - We will be **Spot 77** in the parade. Right before Dell Technologies. Be sure to continue to follow us on social media for live updates on exact location.

Attire: Come as you are! That being said, we do encourage you to wear a Texas Longhorns and/or burnt orange t-shirt and comfortable shoes! The parade route is approximately 1 mile, so please dress accordingly.

Prepare for the heat! We've seen record heat with multiple days on end over 100 degrees. We encourage folks to come prepared and look out for one another. - Bring plenty of water. We will have some free water bottles and Austin Pride be selling water but we highly encourage folks to bring their own so we don't run out in case of an emergency. - Recommended to bring sunscreen, a hat, and an umbrella for shade.

Transportation: Public parking will be limited and traffic is expected to be heavy. The Austin Pride Foundation advises taking advantage of carpooling and public transportation.

Parking is available at State Parking Garage A at 1401 San Jacinto Blvd. There is also metered parking limited to 3 hours on Saturday from 11 a.m.– midnight and free outside those hours. UT students, faculty, and staff may ride Capital Metro mainline buses free by swiping a valid UT photo ID upon entering the bus.

The surrounding area has bus stops for CapMetro routes 6, 7, 10, 103, 111, 142, 171, and more! Routes 7, 10, 103, 111, and 171 go from the UT Alumni Center to downtown.

Getting home: We want everyone to be safe getting home after the parade. We encourage students to take advantage of the UT Night Rides and Sure Walk programs.
