RULES OF THE ROAD

GOALS OF THE PROGRAM

The goal of the Texas Exes Flying Longhorns Travel Program is to provide excellent and exciting discovery, adventure, and educationally oriented travel opportunities to Texas Exes members and their families. All trip participants are expected to enjoy traveling as part of a group—and also to be tolerant of the occasional changes, delays, or minor mishaps that are part of any kind of travel.

ELIGIBILITY & MEMBERSHIP

Participation in a Flying Longhorns trip is offered as a membership benefit. One Texas Exes membership among family members traveling is the minimum membership requirement. Membership from all travelers is welcomed, whether or not they attended or graduated from The University of Texas at Austin. Membership dues are non-refundable but are 80% taxdeductible. There are several levels available (details at texasexes.org/join.) Life Membership is a great option and can be paid in installments incurring no finance charges.

TRIP RESERVATIONS & CONDITIONS

Reservations will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis with a paid deposit. Once a trip's brochure is published, please fax in the registration form included, or call the number listed with your credit card information. Early booking is encouraged to ensure availability. If the trip of your choice is full when we receive your reservation, you usually can be placed on a waiting list—and often you can be accommodated later. If a trip has not met a minimum number of participants at 120 days prior to departure, the trip could be rescheduled or cancelled.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

To enjoy the Flying Longhorns experience, participants have the responsibility to select a trip appropriate to their abilities and interests. The tour staff is responsible for the group as a whole and will not be able to assist individuals extensively. For most trips, the participant will need to have the ability to climb sets of stairs that may not have handrails, walk on uneven surfaces, stand for at least two hours, and keep pace with the other travelers during long, busy days that start early. We recommend that participants be able, in general, to walk a mile in 30 minutes or less.
